LPG valve block installation: pump must be switched off

LPG block variants

The AZURA® Pump P2.1L and the BlueShadow Pump 80 P can be equipped with a low-pressure gradient (LPG) valve block to deliver binary or ternary LPG gradients. The following variants of the LPG valve block are available:

Pump	Gradient type	Article no.
AZURA® Pump P 2.1L	Binary	AZZ00AA
	Ternary	AZZ00AB
Blueshadow 80P	Binary	AZZ00AA-1
	Ternary	AZZ00AB-1

Pre-installation procedure


Component defect

If the LPG valve block is installed while the pump is switched on, severe damage to components such as the pump's circuit board may occur.

→ Make sure that the pump is switched off before installation.

Procedure

- 1. Ensure that the pump is switched off and pull the power plug.




Fig. 1 LPG valve block protection cap on Blueshadow 80 P (left) and AZURA® Pump P 2.1L (right)

- 2. Remove the yellow protection cap (see Fig. 1).
- **3.** Follow the steps given in the pump's instructions:
- V6840 for AZURA Pump P2.1L
- <u>V7680</u> for BlueShadow Pump 80P
